

The following By Laws were adopted at the 10/06/2018 meeting.

The Committee addressed all the concerns that were presented to them. After meeting and discussing they made the following recommendations: Each recommendation was presented at the meeting and each were approved to become a part of our By Laws:

1. Standing Rule VI - Meetings - The Standing Rules clearly state that if you wish to change the meeting day, it must be voted on by the members before the campout. (No changes were made. We have no control over Samborees schedules.)
2. Standing Rule XIV - Wagon master. G. The Wagon Masters may be reimbursed up to \$2.00 per person for members and guests in attendance.
3. Standing Rule XIV - Wagon master H. Adult guests who attend meals and are not interested in joining the Chapter will be asked to pay the \$2.00 per person meal charge. The chapter member that invited them may pay for them.
4. Standing Rule XVI - Membership Identification - B - Name tags shall we worn at chapter events including meetings, social hour and on-site meals.
